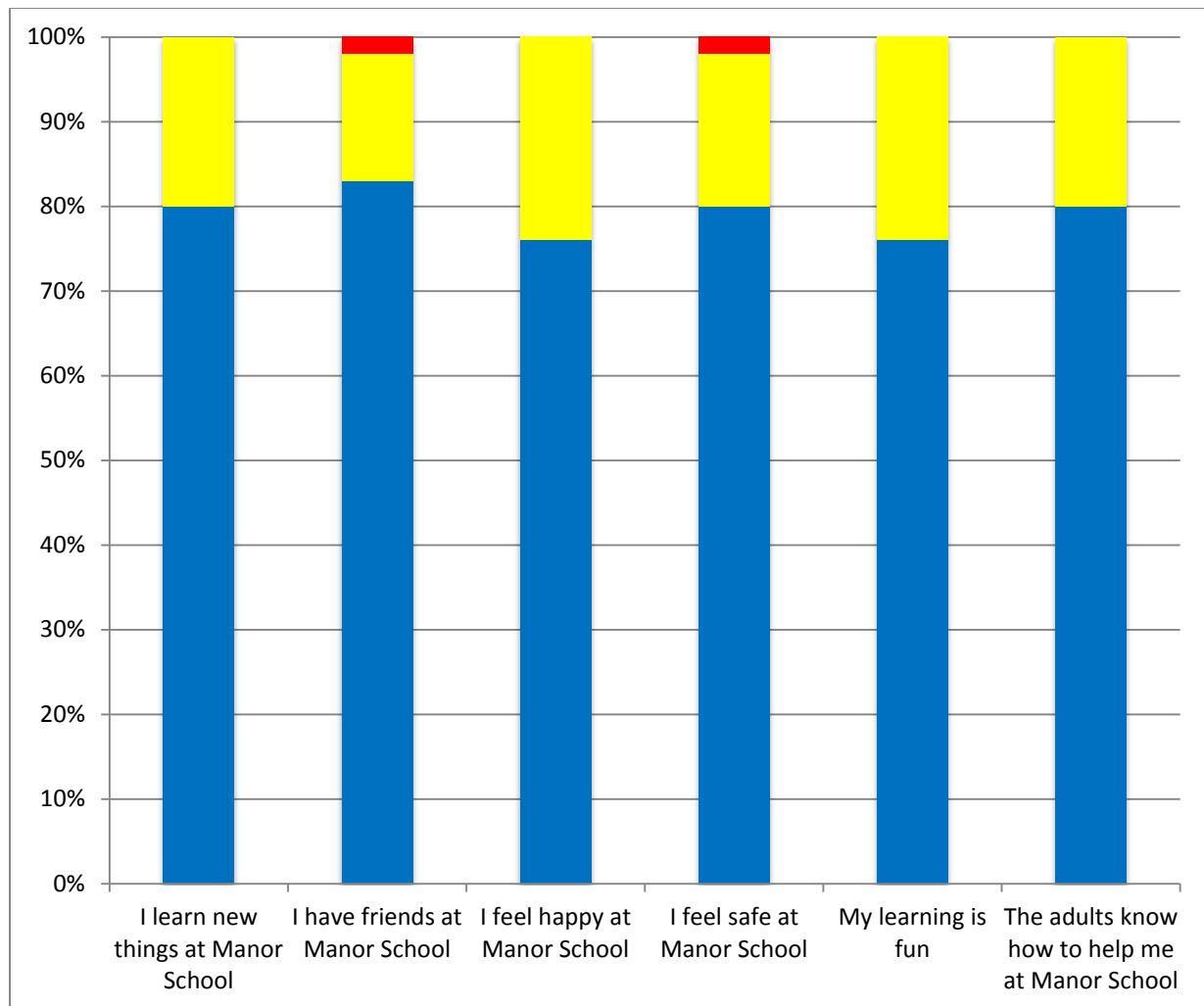

## Comparative Analysis 2014-15 – 2015-16

### 2014-15

The very large majority of pupils say that they always learn new things, have friends and enjoy the food at Manor School.

The large majority of pupils report that they always feel happy, safe and that the adults know how to help them at Manor School.

### 2015-16

The very large majority of pupils continue to say that they always learn new things, and have friends at Manor School.

Following a focus upon pupil perception of behaviour led by School Council and whole school displays. The very large majority of pupils now report that they always feel safe at Manor School.

Following the development of PIP targets the very large majority of pupils now report that the adults always know how to help them at school.

The large majority of pupils continue to say that they always feel happy at school.

One new question was developed. The large majority report that they always find their learning to be fun.
